Remember to notify us (BFCS) if you no longer pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax equal to the tax we reclaim on your payments (in 2016 it is 25p for every £1 you give - this may vary in future years depending on government budget changes). Please also notify us if you move house or flat.

If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief you should contact your local tax office for advice.
